NATCO Plea: Delhi High Court Quashes Novartis Patent

The Delhi High Court upheld the writ petition filed by Natco Pharma staying the patent granted to Novartis A.G. on 14.12.2022 for its top selling heart failure therapy Vymada, sold internationally as Entresto. Justice Hari Shankar in his order annulled the patent awarded to Novartis, and has asked the Controller of Patents & Designs to hear the opposition to the patent. Natco filed a writ petition citing procedural irregularities and violation of principles of natural justice by the Assistant Controller of Patents and designs in awarding Patent to Novartis drug on 14.12.2022. Novartis stated that the order shall be reviewed carefully by them before taking an appropriate action to defend its revoked Patent. The company will stay committed to protecting their patents rights for Enteresto/Vymada.

Entresto is the chemical combination of Sacubitril and Valsartan. The patents of Entresto fixed dose combination are set to expire on 16.01.2022. As a result of this expiry, a lot of Indian Pharmaceutical companies will be able to launch their generic versions of the drug.
