EDITORIAL

Emerging Trends for India –Breakthrough in Innovation, IP positioning and Global Trade

Recent spate of negotiations for FTA's, JV's and global investments into India has coincided with major reforms in regulatory systems. The Drugs and Medical Devices and Cosmetics Bill, 2023 is poised for imminent introduction in the Parliament. The regulatory landscape of India is likely to see major revamp for the better. The outdated nearly a century old Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940 is being replaced by the new proposed Act, The Drugs and Medical Devices and Cosmetics Act, 2023. On June 28, 2023 the Cabinet has approved the National Research Foundation Bill 2023 for approval in Parliament soon. This is intended to strengthen the R&D ecosystem in the country. The Government funded institutions (like DST/DBT/DSIR/BIRAC/CSIR/ICAR) and others are spearheading the renaissance in Indian innovation across a wide spectrum and fuelling the start-up ecosystem. Not to be left behind, the Indian Academia is also keeping pace and soaring high. The rank of Indian Universities in the World University Rankings has gone from 12 in 2014 to 45 in 2023-24. Indian Franchise industry is also expected to grow to USD 150 Billion in coming years. The International Fortune 500 and other leading Global brand leaders are signing up for Joint Ventures in India with leading industry groups. In line with global expectations and Indian IP and Data Protection Bills are also being tabled in Parliament which is expected to receive support from the currently buoyant Indian innovation oriented Industry and Research laboratories.

The recent initiatives being undertaken by Prof. (Dr.) Unnat Pandit, Controller General of Patents, Designs and Trademarks is augmenting the National initiatives in a major thrust. With growing emphasis and empowerment of innovation culture in India, the Industry Academia Research Institutes collaborations and joint research initiatives are also expected to get impetus and the resultant contribution to India's emergence as a global leader across Innovation and IP based infrastructural growth to emerge as an attractive destination for Global investments, is imminent.

Eligibility Conditions

A candidate must be either:-

- a) a citizen of India, or a subject of Nepal, or a subject of Bhutan, or a Tibetan refugee who came over to India before 1st January, 1962 with the intention of permanently settling in India, or
- a person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, East African countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania, Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia and Vietnam with the intention of permanently settling in India (subject to such other further relaxations); and
- c) A candidate must have attained the age of 21 years and must not have attained the age of 35 years as on the last date of submission of online application. The upper age limit of 35 years will be relaxable by up to a maximum of 5 years, that is up to the maximum upper age limit of 40 years, in the case of Government servants in accordance with the instructions or orders issued by the Central Government (subject to such other further relaxations).
